Varsity Competition

Students who are blind and visually impaired in grades 7-12, both boys and girls, who attend KSB full-time and Short Term Program, or attend Jefferson County schools may compete in the following sports:

Track and Field
Goalball
Wrestling
Cheerleading
Swimming
Forensics



KSB competes in the NCASB Conference which includes schools for the blind from the north central states. Students may travel to the schools throughout the season and a combined conference meet is held at the conclusion of each sport. Wrestlers compete with member schools of the Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA)



Varsity Eligibility

- Students at least 14-years-old, or in grades 7-12
- KHSAA Physical and Parental Permission Forms on file
- KSB Student Athlete Guidelines
- Athletic Guidelines for LEA students
- Maintain good scholastic achievement and behavior

Grades are reported weekly. Any student having an F or two D's is ineligible to participate in sports for that week. Unacceptable behavior will result in a student being ineligible for the next seven days.

Forensics

This program is available to students who wish to participate in speech competition. It includes categories such as poetry, impromptu speaking, serious and humorous interpretation and other forms of public speaking. Students compete against other NCASB schools.

Junior Varsity Program



K-6 students develop their athletic skills through participation in track and field, goalball, wrestling, cheerleading and swimming. These students compete in track and field in the Bill Roby Games in the fall. Goalball, wrestling

and cheerleading are held during the Annual JV Meet (Little NC) in the winter and an intramural meet in the spring.

Junior Varsity Eligibility

- Students must be in grades K-6
- Have a signed permission form on file in the Athletic Director's office
- Maintain good scholastic achievement and behavior
